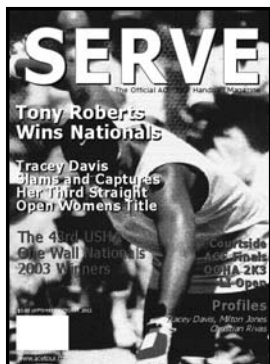


Serve Magazine: May/June 2004
